RE: Reduction in payment standards

Dear Jane Doe.

Effective April 1, 2018, The Housing Authority of the City of Fort Lauderdale (HACFL) began using a new method to calculate the amount of money we will pay toward rent and utilities for each family in our Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) program. Under this new approach, the standard we use to determine the maximum subsidy for a rental unit, known as the payment standard, is based on rent estimates for each ZIP code.

You are receiving this letter because the payment standard for families who live in your ZIP code has been reduced. Please refer to the table below to see how this reduction will impact your rent payment. The HACFL is required to provide 12 months' notice before any reduction in payment standard is effective. These changes will be effective on July 1, 2019.
