



SAFMR Payment Standard Look-up Tables Effective August 1, 2023

Payment standards are used to calculate the maximum subsidy that the PHA will pay toward rent and utilities for families with Housing Choice Vouchers. Effective August 1, 2023, the PHA will use different payment standards in each of eighteen areas. Owners and tenants can identify the applicable payment standard area using the ZIP code where the unit is located.

To determine the applicable payment standard amount for a rental unit:

Step 1. Look for the ZIP code to identify the payment standard area.

^{**} The payment standard is the maximum subsidy a PHA can pay on behalf of a family. Families may select units with rents that are more or less than the PHA payment standard, although the initial rent burden at lease-up may be no greater than 40 percent of monthly adjusted income. The payment standard amount includes an allowance for any tenant-paid utilities. All rents are subject to rent reasonableness determinations by the Housing Authority of the City of Fort Lauderdale.
